
Developing Livestock Water Sources Off the Swift Current Creek

Why we did it

- Take pressure off the creek banks
- Improve grazing distribution
- Improve water use efficiency
- Improve water quality for cattle and down stream water users
- Improve reliability of stock water supply

Cost

- Total cost = \$7500
 - Solar system = \$2500
 - 2 troughs & pipe = \$1600
 - Dam = \$3400
- Demonstration project
- 50:50 cost share with SWCC (max \$3500)
- Funded by Canadian Adaptation and Rural Development Saskatchewan – CARDS
