



## 2022 "Wetlands and Wildlife" Poster Contest Presented by the Saskatchewan Association of Watersheds and the Swift Current Creek Watershed Stewards

If you are in Grades 3 to 4 or 5 to 6, love wetlands and wildlife, and drawing art this is the perfect contest for you! Show the *Swift Current Creek Watershed Stewards* (*SCCWS*) your best wetland scene with all your favourite native wetland plants and animals! Some ideas for your poster could be how wetlands and wildlife interact, how important wetlands are, or even Species at Risk such as Northern Leopard Frogs and Little Brown Bats! Let us see your ideas!

This year our contest is split into two divisions. Grades 3 to 4 and Grades 5 to 6. The top 3 posters in each division will win prizes. The top prize from the Swift Current Creek Watershed in each division is \$75.00 and a SCCWS T-shirt, \$50.00 and a SCCWS T-shirt for second in each division, and third in each division is \$25.00 and a SCCWS T-shirt. The winning entry from the Swift Current Creek Watershed in each division will advance to the provincial finals of the Saskatchewan Association of Watersheds. The Provincial grand prize is \$500.00 to the winning poster in each division and a pizza party for their classroom or organization!

All entries must include the information section provided on the back of this sheet. Posters must be 100% hand drawn by the contestant on 8.5 by 11-inch white paper. You can use any type of art medium you like (markers, crayon, pencil crayon, watercolours, etc...). Posters will be judged on how well the theme of "Wetlands and Wildlife" is demonstrated, artistic skill, and knowledge and accuracy of the theme.

The deadline to submit your poster is **May 31**, **2022**. Entries can also be used by The Swift Current Creek Watershed Stewards in promotions, social media, website, and newsletters, and the names of the winners will also be posted at the end of the contest. Parental permissions are required so please fill in the form to attach to your poster. One entry per contestant. Only those whose posters placed will be notified.
